

ATTENTION CEP LOCAL 191 MEMBERS CONSTITUTIONAL CHANGES

In accordance with Article XVI of the Constitution and Bylaws of CEP Local 191, the following changes will be proposed and voted on at the February 26, 2012 General Membership Meeting:

ARTICLE X – LOCAL COMMITTEES

Under A. The Local shall have the following committees:

Delete 2) Social Committee

Delete 4) Education Committee

Renumber appropriately

D. Duties of Committees

Delete corresponding 2) Social Committee clause

Delete corresponding 4) Education Committee clause

Renumber appropriately

D1 – Finance Committee – (current) The Finance Committee...to the Executive Board.
(Add the following sentence to this clause) Finance Committee members are also required to attend the CEP Financial Officers Course.

ARTICLE XII – LOCAL OFFICERS, EXECUTIVE BOARD CHAPEL CHAIRPERSONS AND THEIR DUTIES

Section 1 – Local Officer

B. Constitutional Committee is not recommending any change in the total number of board members (21).

Delete current Bb) – Commercial Print Council – renumber appropriately including the listing of workplaces covered under each council to read as follows:

Ba) The Winnipeg Newspaper Council-consisting of workers covered under The Winnipeg Free Press Inside Workers contract and the Winnipeg Free Press Carriers contract, the Winnipeg Sun Editorial, Advertising and Mailroom/Bindery departments.

b) The Rural Manitoba Newspaper Council –consisting of Brandon Sun and any other rural papers organized by the local.

c) The Northwestern Ontario Council-consisting of the Chronicle/Journal and any other workplaces organized the local in Northwestern Ontario.

d) The Graphical Council-consisting of workers covered under the Winnipeg Free Press Pressman Contract, The Winnipeg Sun Web, Sheetfed and Pre-Press Departments, Transcontinental LGM Coronet Printing, The United Way Winnipeg.

Add e) The Composite Council-consisting of workplaces not covered in the above.

Delete ii) Corresponding to the Commercial Print Council-renumber appropriately.

Add v) at least one (1) member from the composite council.

Section 3 – Local Chapel Chairperson

A

1. (Current clause) In each certification under the jurisdiction of this Local, the executive board shall determine the number of chapels to be established. One member in each chapel shall be chosen to preside over it who shall be known in his/her official capacity as chairperson of the chapel. If nobody lets their name stand for election as chapel chairperson, he/she shall be appointed by the Local President.

Delete (chosen) and replace with (elected in May of even numbered years).
Delete (who) and replace with whom.

2. (Current clause) Large chapels may elect assistant chapel chairpersons as the chapel deems necessary.

Delete (as the chapel deems necessary) and replace with (at the same time as the chapel chairpersons).
