



PROMOTING EQUALITY: A CEP 2012 SCHOLARSHIP



FOR WOMEN IN MALE DOMINATED FIELDS

One scholarship promoting equality worth \$2,000 in recognition of the National Day of Remembrance and Action on Violence and children of members pursuing full time post-secondary education at a recognized institution such as university, college, CEGEP, technical or other schools, in non-traditional fields of trades, technology, operations and blue collar. The term “nontraditional employment” refers to an occupation in which women are less than 50% of the total workforce. **To see if your occupation qualifies for the Scholarship, you can verify by going on the Statistics Can/ada website a, select the occupation and click on “important fact” to see if your occupation has more than 50% males.**

The scholarship is available to **WOMEN** who are students and **HAVE COMPLETED THEIR SECONDARY STUDIES** (11th or 12th grade, Secondary V) and enter or **UNDERTAKE POST-SECONDARY STUDIES** at college, university, CEGEP or technological institutes. The following applicants are eligible:

- ✓ CEP members in good standing
- ✓ Children of CEP members in good standing
- ✓ Children of CEP members who passed away while in good standing
- ✓ Children of CEP members who retired in good standing

The selection of successful applicant will be made by a person appointed by the President on behalf of the Executive Board. The selection made by that person will be final.
